PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The National Certificate in ABET Practice prepares participants for the facilitation of adult learning at ABET Levels 1 and 2 by developing competencies in planning, facilitating and evaluating learning events. The programme consists of three compulsory core modules and one elective module. Module one covers the fundamentals of adult basic education and training. Module two will enable learners to plan for facilitation. Module three covers facilitation and assessment. In the final (elective) module learners have the opportunity to build on an elected fundamental area of literacy skills.

DURATION AND MODE OF DELIVERY

- The programme is offered over a period of 12 months
- Online, blended or face to face
- All options include self-study, assignment writing as well as examinations and group presentations and assessments
